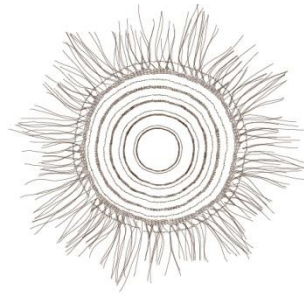


BEQUEST GUIDELINES

We understand that you may wish to arrange for all or part of your gift to the Karrkad-Kanjdji Trust to be made in the form of a bequest.

All bequests received by the Karrkad-Kanjdji Trust will be directed to the trust fund where they will remain intact in perpetuity, generating many times their value for the support of the environment, people and culture of West Arnhem Land.

You may wish to leave an unrestricted bequest, with interest generated directed to the area of highest priority. Alternately, if you would like your gift to benefit a specific area we would be pleased to help you plan appropriately.

You may choose to leave:

- ☼ the residue of your estate, after other bequests and costs
- ☼ a particular asset (life insurance policy, real estate, work of art, etc.)
- ☼ a specified sum of money
- ☼ a percentage of your estate

While we recommend that you seek legal advice before including a bequest in your will, below is an example of how wording for a bequest to the Karrkad-Kanjdji Trust in your will might read:

"I give [(a specific amount or gift) or (a percentage) or (the residue) of my estate] to Karrkad-Kanjdji Limited as trustee for the Karrkad-Kanjdji Trust to be used for [(the general purposes of the Karrkad-Kanjdji Trust) or (a particular purpose)]. The written receipt of the Secretary or other officer of Karrkad-Kanjdji Limited may be accepted by my executors as a full and complete discharge."

We encourage you to share your plans with us so that we may recognise you for your generosity during your lifetime and keep you informed of our activities.
